The Board was presented with the 3 bid results to repair and overlay the failed section of Calle Pino. The apparent low bidder was All American at \$92,000.00. This repair included 6"of class 2 base and 3.5" of new asphalt in two lifts.

Director McDaniel explained the project and the reasons the roads committee believes this area experienced failures. The District did hire a soils engineer and the compaction test showed proper compaction. Staff was asked to seek an outside engineer to evaluate the failed area and John Rogers has been contacted. He has not had an opportunity to evaluate the information yet. Dir. McDaniel asked that this matter be continued until the engineer can take a look at the soils report and road itself. There may be a need to have a Special Board Meeting in 2 weeks to go over the project.
