ORDINANCE NO. 8

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE OF TENAJA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT ESTABLISHING WARNING SIGNS AT INTERSECTIONS OF TENAJA ROAD AND VIA VOLCANO AND TENAJA ROAD AND CALLE PINO

RECITATIONS

- A. On July 6, 1989, the Board of Directors adopted Ordinance No. 6 to establish speed limits and traffic control signs; and
- B. Paragraph B 3 and Paragraph B 4 of Exhibit A states that a 3-way stop sign shall be place at the intersections of Tenaja Road/Via Volcano and Tenaja Road/Calle Pino and
- c. Only one of the stop signs were actually erected at each tee intersection and dangerous conditions continue to prevail at those intersections.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TENAJA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT HEREBY ORDAINS THAT EXHIBIT A OF ORDINANCE NO. 6 BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

PARAGRAPH B 3

"A one (1) way stop sign at the intersection of Tenaja Road and Calle Pino to control south bound traffic on Calle Pino, together with a warning sign, clearly visible reading 'CROSS TRAFFIC DOES NOT STOP'"

PARAGRAPH B 4

"A one (1) way stop sign at the intersection of Tenaja Road and Via Volcano to control east-bound traffic on Tenaja Road, together with a warning sign, clearly visible to east-bound motorist, reading 'CROSS-TRAFFIC DOES NOT STOP'"

Section 1. <u>Continuing Effect</u>. Except as specifically amended herein, the remaining terms of Ordinance No. 6 shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u> The is an urgency measure and shall, accordingly, become effective immediately. The nature of the urgency is that unless appropriately forewarned, the lives motorist will be endangered.
